2. Entries limited to 50. Handicap limit 10.4 on entry. Should applications exceed this number preference will be given to lower handicaps. The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning a reason.
3. An entrance fee of £25 must be forwarded together with the entrance form to the Competition Secretary,

5. All matters relating to the Competition shall be settled by the Committee whose decision shall be final.
6. Prizes will be awarded for each of the first 5 Aggregate Gross Scores, for the Best Aggregate Handicap Score and for the Best Gross Score in the Morning and Afternoon rounds. In the event of a tie for the Bowl there will be a "Sudden Death" Play-Off, immediately after the last card has been returned, to determine the winner. All other ties will be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes. No competitor may win more than one prize.
